

## 2022 IEEE REGION 3 SOUTHEAST CON STUDENT Presentation COMPETITION RULES

### I. OVERVIEW

In the IEEE Region 3 Student Presentation Competition, IEEE undergraduate students will have the opportunity to refine their technical presentation skills. IEEE students will create a presentation and present to a self assembled audience. The team will then submit their presentation files and recording of the presentation in advance of SoutheastCon. Finalists will be announced in advance of SoutheastCon and will come on site to SoutheastCon to present their presentation to another panel of judges.

### II. Presentation Requirements

The technical presentation should be able to clearly describe your technical contributions and to convince others about the importance of the technical aspects in the allowed content areas below. There will be 5 content areas allowed this year:

- 1) Internship/non-profit project
- 2) Class research project
- 3) Personal interest on a technical topic
- 4) Training/tutorial material
- 5) Technical pitch for business sponsorship

# III. Dates, Process, and Registration

## Key Dates

March 20th, 2022 Deadline for submitting presentation slides, abstract, and recorded presentation

March 27th, 2022 Finalists for the competition are announced

April 1st, 2022 Finalists present on site at SoutheastCon

April 2st, 2022 Winners are announced at banquet

## Competition Process

Below is a breakdown of the competition process. The remaining section of this document will address the details needed to complete each step:

1. Compose a presentation abstract and presentation slide deck
2. Assemble a audience panel that you will present to
3. Present and record your presentation to your audience
4. Email [jeesacregion3@gmail.com](mailto:jeesacregion3@gmail.com) your presentation slides, abstract, and recorded presentation by submission deadline
5. Finalists will attend SoutheastCon 2022 and present their same presentation to a judging panel

## Registration

There are two registrations that students need to be aware of; conference registration and competition registration. All students competing in student competitions must register for both the conference and the competition. Information for both registrations are as follows:

- 1) Conference registration (i.e. IEEE SoutheastCon 2022 registration)  
At least one member from the student branch must register for the conference registration in order for the university design to be entered into the promotional design competition.
- 2) Student Presentation Competition registration  
Each student competition in the Presentation Competition must register on the competition registration forum on the SoutheastCon website. There are no fees for students to register for the Presentation competition (aside from the costs for students to register for the conference)

## IV. PRESENTATION COMPETITION RULES

### Recorded Presentation Requirements

The Presentation must take place over a platform that allows verbal and video communication, live streaming, and can be recorded and uploaded to youtube.

The presentation must be to a live audience of at least 5 people. This means that you must have 5 people watching your presentation stream live while you record. Your audience should be able to hear and see you during your presentation. It is on the students to find their audience members and schedule their presentation with them. The requirements on who qualifies to be an audience member is that they must belong to at least one of the following categories:

- a) University faculty/staff
- b) IEEE Professional member
- c) Professional in a technical industry

You must email your audience a copy of your presentation slides prior to the start of your presentation. The length of the presentations must be between 10-12 minutes. You must then allow for a Q&A session with your audience and each audience member should ask 1 question. You then must allow for a feedback session and open the floor for any of your audience members to give you feedback if they would like. The presentation, Q&A session, and feedback session should also be captured in your recording.

Disqualifications may be made by mutual consent of SAC. Causes include, but are not limited to, unethical behavior during the competition and academic dishonesty.

### Finalist Presentation Requirements

The finalists will present their same presentation to a panel on site at SoutheastCon.
